Dr. Pusey has more than 25 years of experience in medicine, international clinical trial management, Clinical Research Organization (CRO) services and global pharmaceutical sales, marketing and operations roles. As one of PharmaVOICE magazine's Top 100 Most Inspirational Leaders, James is focused on raising investment funds, orchestrating strategic change, and driving growth. James has a track record in a variety of Global Healthcare Sciences organizations, and in the last 10 years has built three CROs with significant Global operations, and namely MDS (now INC), Theorem Clinical Research as Founding CEO, and more recently WuXiPRA Clinical Research with over 400 staff based in China, and once again as the Founding President. Currently James is working with Medpace as Senior Vice-President Clinical Operations based in Cincinnati.

From 2009 until 2013 James founded the Global CRO Theorem Clinical Research as a management buy-out from Omnicare Inc. the US based Pharmacy Distribution Fortune 500 company. James' roles at Theorem included President & CEO, Executive Chairman, and Board Director. This CRO now boasts 1,300 staff in 32 countries, and has \$350 million in contracts. Prior to Theorem from 2007 through 2009 Dr. Pusey served as SVP and General Manager of Global Clinical Development at MDS Pharma Services. In both these CROs a significant strategic building block was clinical trial growth in Asia-Pacific, and with a special focus on China. James' INC, Theorem, and WuXiPRA are today all vibrant healthy businesses in China, the USA and Europe.

Other leadership roles include the President & CEO of Orthologic Inc., a publically traded biotechnology company based out of Phoenix Arizona, Executive Vice President of the Pfizer & Serono joint venture in Multiple Sclerosis (MS) which successfully took the injectable MS treatment Rebif to #1 in North America, and led the team that funded Oral Cladribine Phase III trials in MS to their US NDA submission.

Prior to joining Pfizer & Serono, Dr. Pusey served in a variety of roles at AstraZeneca and SmithKline Beecham, and prior to his business career, Dr. Pusey was a practicing physician in the Royal Free, King George, St Bartholomews, and Whittington hospitals all based in London UK.
